### Tasting Notes:

Medium deep ruby color, deep, complex, spicy, blueberry aromas with toasty notes, ripe, rich blueberry fruit, big complex and bold with earthy notes, moderate tannin and oak, good structure and balance, long finish. Complex and bold, this Pinot has silkiness in the middle that really makes the blueberry fruit stand out. Delicious.
