Tasting Notes:

Homer is a careful selection of the best barrels in our cellar. The fruit comes from our original planting at Shea Vineyard in 1989 blended with a small amount of our new Dijon Clones fruit. The wine is dark and concentrated with aromas of blackberries, currants and espresso bean. Black plums, chewy tannins and spice fill the mouth. The finish lingers on and on.
