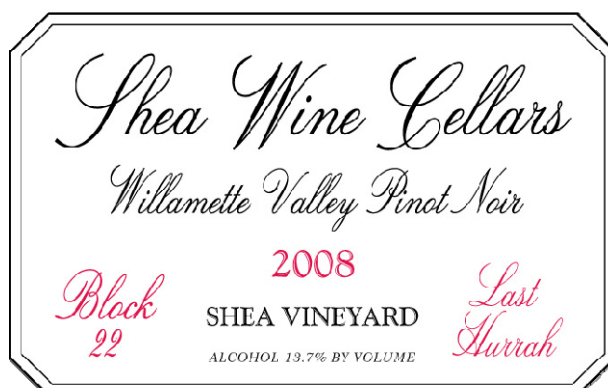

It gives up a spicy perfume with notes of cedar, spice box, underbrush, and an amalgam of red fruits. Already complex and a bit more layered than the Estate cuvee, it is packed with sweet fruit containing enough structure to evolve for another 3-4 years. This lengthy effort will offer pleasure from 2013 to 2023 while going out in style."*
