Tasting Notes:

A steep, south facing slope at the top of Shea Vineyard's east hill (close to 600 feet in elevation at the top), North Block is usually the last pick at Shea Vineyard. This prolonged ripening on the vine leads to full flavor development without excess sugar. Rose, blueberry, and blackberry aromatics lead to a structured palate with concentrated blue and black fruit.
