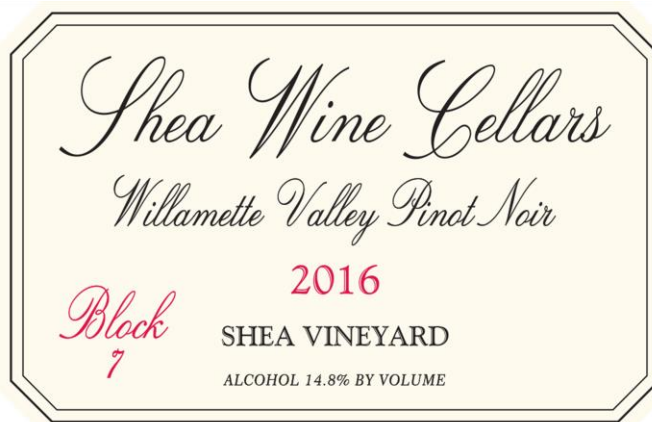

Made entirely of Wädenswil clone Pinot noir, this wine has the earthy, savory characteristics typical of our prior Block 7 releases.
